### **Time To Pay Policy on Cases heard on or after July 1, 2024**

Defendants receiving Social Security benefit or Supplemental Security Income being the only source of income shall be exempt from making payments for Fines/Cost until another source of income is updated with the Court. As long as your sole income remains unchanged, your account will not go to collections and no due date is applied.

- Any restitution you may have been ordered to pay is not included in this exemption of payment and is due as the court has ordered. You are still required to pay restitution and any collection fees or interest if after 90 days past due.

Finalized cases -90 days from the time of disposition to pay Fines /Cost unless defendant enters into a Time to Pay Agreement.

Jail Time- An additional 90 days will be granted upon release from jail, only when a time to pay agreement is signed.

If the defendant is unable to make payment within ninety days of final disposition where costs are owed, the court will assess a one-time fee of \$10.00 to cover the costs of management of the defendant's account. The defendant must execute a time to pay agreement.

Accounts outside of the SSI or SS benefits will go into collections if the fines and cost are not paid after the 90 days, provided there was not a time to pay agreement signed, or at the expiration date of the time to pay agreement.

#### EXTENSIONS

An extension of the time to pay agreement may be requested by the defendant prior to the expiration date of the time to pay agreement.

#### INTEREST

Criminal and Traffic cases: Interest will accrue on the 181st day after final disposition or release from incarceration if payment is not made in full.
