Assignments of Error

1. The court was plainly wrong in finding that Gabi's Will gave his estate to Nidal, individually, and not to his Wife and Daughters.
2. The court was plainly wrong in ruling that it is impossible to give effect to all parts of the Will.
7. It was an abuse of discretion for the court to deny reconsideration of its construction of the Will.
